

## **PIECING MOSAIC TILE DESIGNS**

### **Supplies:**

Freezer Paper

Masking tape

Pencil and eraser

Colored pencils (3 or 4 different colors)

Rotary mat and cutter and basic ruler

Paper scissors

Small rotary ruler with ¼ inch marked clearly from an outside edge

(Bias Square, Omni 1x 6, or Omni 1 x 12 rulers work well.)

Sewing machine with power cord and foot pedal

Thread scissors

Pins, IBC silk pins preferred (available at workshop if you can't find them locally)

Extra machine needles

Thread

Removable tape (A Scotch brand product)

Extension cord and power bar (optional)

Yardstick ruler (also called compass points – optional)

### **Projects:**

There will be two projects for you to choose from. None of them are large or we wouldn't get very far during a one day class. You may choose any one of the projects to work on during the workshop. If you have my book, Masterful Machine Pieced Quilts, you may choose any project from the book. Be sure to take the CD to a copy shop and have your pattern printed before the workshop. If you prefer you may spend the day developing your own mosaic design. If this is your choice you will not need sewing machine or fabric, but will need a large piece of paper (at least 36 inches wide).

### **Fabrics:**

Background

For the largest design you will need ½ yard of background fabric.

Small amounts of fabrics that contrast well with the background

None of these needs to be larger than an 8 inch square

The more fabrics you have the more choices you will have as you develop your design.
