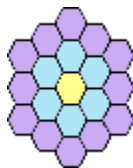

One-unit patterns have never been easier to make!

The stamp allows you to quickly and easily stamp your fabric. You cut out the hexagons, diamonds and other shapes, and then sew them accurately by hand or by machine. These stamps can make many other traditional patterns such as the Tumbling Block, Texas Star, Dresden Plate, and six pointed Stars. Other shapes and patterns are also available.

Supply List

- 1 Hexagon or other Stamp
- Pre-inked Stamp pad
- Scrap of one color for center of flower - about 2-1/2" square
- Scrap at least 3" x 16" print fabric for 6 hexagons for inner petals
- Scrap at least 6" x 16" coordinating print fabric for 12 hexagons for outer petals
- White/Natural color cotton at least 9" x 22" for 18 hexagons for background
- Small SHARP straight pins
- Sharps (appliqué) needles size 11 or 10
- Thimble
- Fabric scissors
- Re-closeable plastic sandwich bags
