

Cutting Instructions for ONE block:

| Color | Number to Cut | Size (unfinished) |
|------------|---------------|---------------------------|
| Boot top | 1 | 4-1/2 by 6-1/4" rectangle |
| - | 1 | 2 by 6" rectangle |
| Doothoo | 1 | 1-1/4 x 4-1/2" strip |
| Boot base | 1 | 2-1/4" square |
| | 2 | 1-1/2" squares |
| Boot heel | 1 | 2 x 3" rectangle |
| | 1 | 4-1/2 x 7" rectangle |
| Background | 3 | 1-1/2" squares |
| - | 2 | 2" squares |

Sewing Instructions for ONE block:

The instructions below can be used to make this block by using a "sew-and-flip" method. Use large squares and rectangles, and sew smaller squares diagonally atop them – press them open and cut away the excess fabric. It's fast and easy – just take care in sewing careful diagonal lines. You can mark the diagonals with a pencil on the reverse side.



NOTE: All triangles sewn in these instructions are made by sewing squares to a rectangle – place the square on top of the rectangle, right sides together. Stitch DIAGONALLY across the square. Flip the resulting triangle in place and press flat; trim away excess fabric.

- 1. Sew a 1-1/2" background square on the top of the boot top rectangle; flip/press/trim. Do this again on the other corner. Next, sew two 1-1/2" squares on the bottom of the boot top rectangle and follow the same sew-and-flip steps.
- 2. Sew the $1-1/4 \times 4-1/2$ " strip of boot base fabric to the bottom of this unit; flip/press/trim.
- 3. Sew a 2-1/4" square of boot fabric to the lower left corner of the 4-1/2" x 7" background fabric. Flip/press/trim.
- 4. Sew a 1-1/2" background square on the right side of the 2" x 6" boot base rectangle; sew a 2" background square on the left side of the rectangle. Sew a 2" background square on the left side of the boot heel. Flip/press/trim all seams."
- 5. Lay out all of the units prepared so far.
- 6. Stitch units together first, sew the larger rectangles together. Next, sew the bottom two pieces together. Finally, sew the top pair to the bottom pair of units. Press. Your finished boot should measure 8-1/2" square, unfinished.
