House	Cut 3-	1 ½" x 3 ½" strip	
	Cut 1-	1 ½" x 2 ½" strip	
	Cut 1-	1 ½" x 6 ½" strip	
Roof	Cut 1-	2 1⁄2" x 6 1⁄2" strip	
Background Sky	Cut 2-	2 ¹ / ₂ " squares	

Sewing Instructions:

- 1. Sew the 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " house strip to the bottom of the window square. Press the seam away from the window. Sew the 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " house strip to the right side of the window. Press seam away from the window.
- 2. Sew 2 of the 1 1/2" x 3 ¹/₂" house strips to either side of the door strip. Press the seams away from the door. Sew the door unit to the window unit.
- 3. Sew the $1 \frac{1}{2}$ x $6 \frac{1}{2}$ house strip onto the top of the house. Press seam toward the top strip.
- 4. Draw a diagonal line on each $2\frac{1}{2}$ " sky squares. Place on either side of the roof strip. Stitch on the drawn line, trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " from seams and press toward the sky pieces.
- 5. Sew the roof unit onto the house unit. Press the seam toward the house.
