You can make **ONE** block... **OR** you can make **TWO** blocks **AND** be eligible for the lottery block drawing! Make as many pairs as you wish. The drawing to win the second set of blocks will be held during the Guild meeting on the night of the block due date.

<b>Pattern</b>	<b>Sawtooth Star</b>	
<b>Block Size</b>	Unfinished: 8-1/2" x 8-1/2" Finished: 8" x 8"	
<b>Colors</b>	Use one Christmas fabric for the star and a contrasting Christmas fabric for the background.	

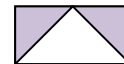
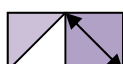
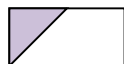
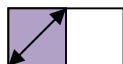
**Cutting instructions for one block:**

Star Fabric	Cut (1) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" square for center Cut (8) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares
Background Fabric	Cut (4) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" for corners Cut (4) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

Draw diagonal lines on the back side of the 2 1/2" Star squares.

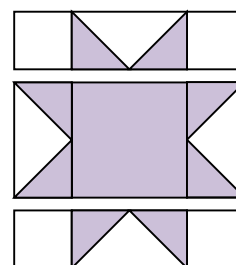
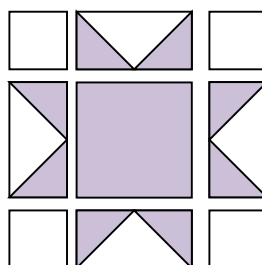


Place a Star square on the one corner of the background rectangle. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim and press to the Star fabric. Repeat on the other end of the rectangle.



Make 4 of these units.

Assemble the block in rows:



Sew the rows together and you have this:
