
LQG Auction / Lottery Block Bonanza SCRAPPY STRING BLOCK

Make <u>one</u> block for auction **OR** make <u>two blocks</u> and be eligible for the lottery block drawing! The drawing for the second set of blocks will be held during the Guild meeting the night the block is due.

Pattern:	Scrappy String Block
Block Size:	Unfinished: 8½" x 8½"
	Finished: 8" x 8"
	Center strip should be 2" wide
Colors	Use a black center strip for LQG lottery blocks
	White or other colors create cohesive, interesting patterns for a finished quilt.
	Remaining strings can be any width/color/pattern
	you choose.



Cut a 9" block of muslin for the base. Fold the muslin square in half diagonally and press a crease. Draw a line one inch on both sides of the crease.





Place the center 2" strip of fabric down the middle of the muslin base right side up using the pencil marks as your guide. Place your next strip of fabric along one of the edges of the center strip right side down (fabrics will be right sides together) and sew ¼" from edge. Flip the second strip right side up and press. Continue until you have covered one side of the block. Repeat and cover the other side of the block with strips.





Press the block and trim the uneven edges to 8 ½" square, keeping the selected colored string in the center.
