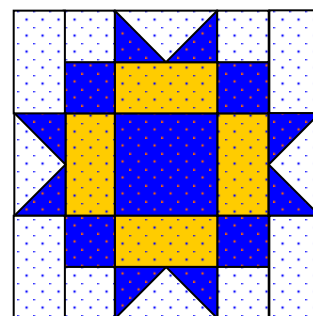


Auction / Lottery Block Bonanza

You can make **one** block for auction **OR** you can make **two blocks** and be eligible for the lottery block drawing! Pattern:	Maple Star
Block Size:	(12½" x 12½") with seam allowances or (12" x 12") finished
Colors:	Cream for the background Two civil war reproduction prints



Cutting Instructions for **ONE** block:

Color	Number to cut	Size	Number to cut	Size
Background (cream)	8	2 ½" X 4 ½" rectangle	4	2 ½" square
Color A	4	2 ½" X 4 ½" rectangle		
Color B	1	4 ½" square	12	2 ½" square

Sewing Instructions for **ONE** block:

<p>1. Make a flying geese unit using the flip and sew technique with a background 2 ½" X 4 ½" rectangle and 2 of the Color B 2 ½" squares. Repeat to make a total of 4 flying geese units.</p>	
<p>2. Sew a 2 ½" background square to each end of a flying geese unit. Make 2 of these units.</p>	
<p>3. Sew a 2 ½" X 4 ½" background rectangle to each end of a flying geese unit. Make 2 of these units.</p>	
<p>4. Make the center nine patch unit using the Color B 4 ½" square, 4 of the Color B 2 ½" squares, and 4 of the Color A 2 ½" X 4 ½" rectangles.</p>	
<p>5. Assemble the block.</p>
