

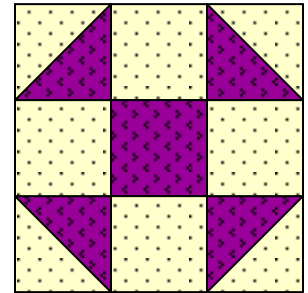
Auction / Lottery Block Bonanza

You can make **one** block for auction **OR** you can make **two blocks** and be eligible for the lottery block drawing! The drawing to win the second set of blocks will be held during the Guild meeting on the night of the block due date.

Due:	Monday March 16, 2009 at the Guild Meeting
Pattern:	Shoofly
Block Size:	(8" x 8") with seam allowances or (7 1/2" x 7 1/2") finished
Colors:	Any bright batik for the shoofly white non-batik for the background

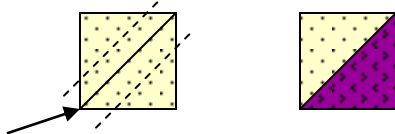


Cutting Instructions for **ONE** block:

Color	Number to cut	Size
Bright Batik Shoofly	2	3 1/2" squares
	1	3" square
White (non-batik) Background	2	3 1/2" squares
	4	3" squares

Sewing Instructions for ONE block:

1. Mark a diagonal line on wrong side of both 3 1/2" white squares.
Place right sides together with the bright batik fabric and stitch 1/4" on either side of diagonal mark.
Cut between stitching; press toward bright batik fabric; trim to 3" square.



2. Lay out the pieces and sew rows together.

Join rows to create block.
