



**LQG Auction / Lottery Block Bonanza**  
**THE EVENING STAR BLOCK – DUE SEPTEMBER 20, 2010**


You can make **ONE** block... **OR** you can make **TWO** blocks **AND** be eligible for the lottery block drawing! Make as many pairs as you wish. The drawing to win the second set of blocks will be held at the Guild meeting on the night of the block due date. <b>Pattern</b>	Evening Star	
<b>Block Size</b>	Unfinished: 8-1/2" x 8-1/2" Finished: 8" x 8"	
<b>Colors</b>	Two different Civil War/reproduction fabrics	

**Sewing Instructions for ONE block:**

- You can either use commercial paper foundations to make the half-square triangles for this block. If you use the paper foundations, you will need enough to make **eight 2-inch finished size half-square triangles**. To make half-square triangles without using foundation paper, cut four 2-7/8 inch squares of fabric A and four from fabric B. Halve each square diagonally. Sew pairs together, along the diagonal, right sides facing each other. Press the seam toward the print fabric. Make eight half-square triangles.


- Once you made your eight half-square triangles made, cut **one 4-1/2 inch square** from fabric A and **four 2-1/2 inch squares** from fabric B.


- Assemble your block, as shown below. Your finished block should measure 8-1/2 inches square (unfinished size).
