Class Description:

Marylou McDonald teaches tips, tricks and techniques for making skinny stems, perfect circles, Pellon flowers, template free appliqué, freezer paper appliqué and pointed leaves.

The class is appropriate for willing and confident beginners as well as advanced appliqué students. The purpose of this block is to select flowers from other Baltimore Album Quilts as did the Baltimore ladies in the 1846 – 1850's. Participants can make the block exactly as it is printed on the pattern. Students are to trace the pattern with the blue marker as it is printed. The class will receive the patterns as a handout of the additional flowers. The pattern for the Baltimore Album Floral Wreath (mlu-0-6) should be purchased prior to the class (will be available at the Aug. and Sept. meetings).

Supply List:

Background fabric

- 22" by 22" background fabric of your choice

Fabrics

- Fat quarters
 - 5 Reds (5 different reds)
 - 2 Blues (1 light & 1 medium)
 - 4 Greens (4 different greens)
 - 4 Yellows (light to dark, some can be in shades of gold)
 - 1 Brown
 - 3 Pinks
 - 1 Purple

These are only suggestions for colors. Please feel free to select from your own color palette.

Prior to the class, please trace the block onto the background fabric using the blue water soluble marker. Trace the block onto freezer paper but not the stems and flower centers. **Please do NOT cut out your freezer paper.**

Basic sewing supplies

- Needles (Roxanne's Appliqué Needles and #8 sharp needles for back basting)
- Scissors (sewing & paper)
- Blue soluble marking pen
- PermaWriter II #01 pen (I will bring some for sale)
- Small photo album to hold appliqué pieces
- Cotton thread to match fabrics and quilting thread
- Freezer paper
- ½ yard of #830 Pellon (I will bring some for sale)
