Quilt Show Judges

Marcia Kaylakie

Marcia has been making, collecting, and appraising quilts since 1988, and is a Quilt and Quilted Textile Appraiser certified by the American Quilter’s Society. Her first book, *Texas Quilts and Quilters: A Lone Star Legacy* won the Texas Writers’ League Violet Crown Award for non-fiction in 2008. She has appeared in numerous books, magazines, newspaper articles, and has been a guest on two television shows in Austin, Texas on the making of religious quilts. Marcia was the curator of the art quilt exhibit *Eye of the Needle* at the Quattro Gallery in Austin, Texas 2006 and curated the exhibit *Gone to Texas: Women and Quilts* at the Susannah Dickinson House Museum in 2012-2013. Marcia is a member of the Austin Area Quilt Guild, the American Quilter’s Society, The International Quilt Association, the American Quilt Study Group, the Lone Star Quilt Study Group, and the Professional Association of Appraisers–Quilted Textiles. Her special interests include Mountain Mist quilts, Texas quilts and quiltmakers, and art quilts. She is currently researching material for 2 more books and scholarly papers. Marcia lives in Round Rock, Texas with her husband, Bill, and their two dogs. She is the thrilled grandmother of 8! An avid quiltmaker, Marcia enjoys a wide variety of styles as well as experimenting with new quilt techniques for her own quilts and has won an award of merit from the National Association of Certified Quilt Judges.

Lois Kindley

Lois Kindley is a candidate of the NACQJ Program. She is a highly awarded, competitive quilt artist and longarm professional who has successfully competed at local, regional, and national levels. She is a veteran fiber artist that has a passion for quilt making. For over 40 years she has shared the love of quilting, by being active in the quilting world, lecturing, designing patterns,

and teaching children, adults, and even inmates the art of quilt making. Having made over one thousand quilts in her lifetime, she stays on top of the shifts and trends in the quilt making industry through continuing education from national teachers and local artists alike. In 2016, Lois began her professional longarm career and has quilted more than 500 quilts. Two of her custom-quilted pieces have been featured on The Quilt Show, one being the show's Block of the Month for 2022. Her quilting and longarm skills have been juried into both the American Quilters Society and International Quilt Festival shows.

Lois has participated in more than 20 different quilt organizations, guilds, and bees through many moves with her husband's career, from Texas to the Pacific Northwest, from New England to the deep South. And, she has appreciated the exposure to regional and cultural influences that have made an impact on her own quilts. Throughout that time, she has gained extensive knowledge and experience of many fiber art techniques that she has used in quilt making and quilt judging.

After serving as quilt show chair for The Trinity Valley Quilt Guild in Fort Worth, her interest to become a certified judge was solidified. There is an extremely high standard and extensive knowledge base that a certified judge must attain. She is currently participating in the National Association of Certified Quilt Judges candidacy program because she recognizes excellence in judging should be as important as excellence in quilt making. Lois has judged many quilt shows across the country, including Florida, Alabama, Oklahoma, and Texas. She co-founded the Quilts of Valor Liberty Piecemakers chapter while living in Huntsville, Alabama, and currently serves in its "LongArmy." She has managed a high school art scholarship program, and has pursued interests in drawing and painting, as well as all forms of needlework. She has custom designed and created both evening gowns and wedding dresses for clients such as the Fort Worth symphony director.

In Lois's words, "My heart longs to positively encourage quilters! I desire to share my love of quilting and see others succeed. I know entrants have worked extremely hard to complete their quilts and are open to having them judged. I aim to inspire you to continue creating and entering quilts into competitions. Quilt shows are a wonderful way to spark creativity in others!"
