



## Seaglass Quilting Workshop Supply List

*During the workshop, participants will learn how to select, prepare, and shape fabrics for the seaglass quilt. We will cover elements of design and layout. Students will be provided free access to Allie's online seaglass class, which includes lessons on quilting and finishing the seaglass quilt. Sewing machines are not needed for the workshop.*

- Blue, Green, and light Neutral scraps (or choose colors you prefer to use for your quilt) approximately 2" - 4" in size in a variety of light and dark fabrics (individual scraps will work, as will jellyroll strips) I recommend having enough for (100) 2" - 4" pieces **\*\*Scraps are preferable, yardage is not recommended**
- 1 yard of Heat n'Bond lite (or other double sided lightweight fusible)
- 1 1/3 yards of quilting cotton. I typically use white or off-white. This will be for the background, backing, and binding of your quilt.
- Iron and Ironing Surface
- Containers (sandwich bag size) to hold prepared pieces (if traveling to workshop)
